CLUB SPOTLIGHT – Northern Attack VBC – WI

Northern Attack Volleyball Club was founded with a simple but powerful vision: to provide high-quality, competitive volleyball opportunities for athletes growing up in rural communities—without asking them to sacrifice balance, family, or who they are outside the sport. We are located in NW Wisconsin about 2 hours from the Twin Cities. We are a small but mighty club that consistently competes with large, well-known programs, often leaving coaches and parents asking, “Who are you and where are you from?” While some athletes have explored bigger Twin Cities clubs over the years, many return to Northern Attack because they value the personal attention, organization, and trust that comes with a smaller program. Bigger isn’t always better—and in large clubs, athletes can easily get lost in the crowd.

At Northern Attack we want every athlete to be seen, supported, and developed. As costs of playing in club volleyball continue to rise this becomes an increasing roadblock for players in rural communities. Despite these obstacles, Northern Attack works intentionally to advocate for our athletes. We attempt to keep costs as low as reasonably possible and provide fundraising opportunities. We try to take a realistic approach to club volleyball by avoiding unnecessary expenses like excessive gear requirements and rigid travel expectations.

We firmly believe that the “flashiest” teams are not always the best teams. We do not need matching warm ups to compete well! We recognize that our players are more than just volleyball athletes. The vast majority of Northern Attack players are multi-sport competitors and we want to fully support that. Our girls balance volleyball with basketball, softball, track, wrestling and more—building athleticism, resilience, and a strong mindset. We view multi-sport participation as a long-term advantage, not a limitation. With many of our athletes being in multi-sports we only have practices once a week and being a national traveling team is just not a realistic option, as we are juggling so many different sports schedules.

Being part of a rural volleyball club may be considered a disadvantage, however, because the athletes are so well rounded we continue to be strong competitors in all of our tournaments. We are gaining ground on social media exposure helping our athletes have more recruiter/college exposure access. We have had several players go on to play at a collegiate level over the years.

Our goal moving forward is to continue developing confident, well-rounded athletes, expanding exposure pathways, and proving that rural players can compete and succeed at the highest levels. Volleyball should be exciting, challenging, and fun—not overwhelming or financially exhausting—and that belief remains at the heart of Northern Attack.
